

The Town Board for the Town of Apple River does ordain as follows:

- A. Town Ordinance Number **5** of the Town of Apple River is hereby created as follows:

ANIMALS NOT TO BE PERMITTED TO RUN AT LARGE

1. It shall be unlawful to permit any livestock to run at large at any time within the limits of the Township of Apple River except to transport said livestock from one farm parcel to another

2. Any person who shall violate this provision of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof forfeit no more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars together with the costs of prosecution for the first offense and not more than Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars together with the costs of prosecution for the second offense within a year.

3. A third violation of this ordinance within one year shall be deemed to be a nuisance subject to injunction and abatement under Chapter 280 Wisconsin Statutes in addition to penalties above provided.

- B. The Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
